 Do you think that it was ok for Avram and Sarai to say that they were brother and sister, so that Avram wouldn't be killed?

 Imagine you were Sarai. How would you feel when your maid started being rude and disrespectful to you?

3) How does the word, fight, link to the Parasha?

Hashem (G-d) commanded Avram (Abram) to, "Go for yourself, from your land and from your birthplace and from your father's house, to the land that I will show you." This land was Cena'an (Canaan) now known as Israel. Hashem says that Avram will be the start of a great nation. Avram and his wife, Sarai, together with their nephew Lot (Lot was Avram's brother's son), travel to the land of Cena'an and when they arrived, Avram built an altar and spread the message of a one G-d because in those times, people used to believe that there were different gods for different things, such as one god for the sun, one god for food, etc.

The land of Israel was hit by a famine so without grumbling, Avram headed to Egypt with his family, for food. Unfortunately Sarai was noticed for her beauty and was taken to Paro's (Pharaoh) palace to become his wife. When asked who he was, Avram escaped death because he said that he and Sarai were brother and sister. If Paro knew he was Sarai's husband, he would be killed. Hashem brought a plague to the land of Egypt which stopped Paro from marrying Sarai and convinced him to return her to Avram. He realised that Avram was Sarai's real husband and in order to stop the plague continuing, he offered great compensation to Avram, with cattle, gold and silver.

When they returned to Cena'an, Avram's shepherds and Lot's shepherds quarreled. Avram suggested that they separate from each other, to maintain peace. Lot chose the land of S'dom (Sodom) that was well irrigated and therefore, great for his cattle but the people there were very nasty. Lot was certain that he would not be influenced by them. Lot was taken captive when the armies of Chedorlaomer and his three allies conquered the cities in the Sedom valley. Avram came to rescue Lot, defeated the kings, and was blessed by Malki Tzedek (Malki-Zedek) the king of Yerushalayim (Jerusalem), known then as Salem.

Hashem made a covenant with Avram, where the exile and persecution of the Jewish people was explained, and the Holy Land, Israel, was promised to the Jewish people as their everlasting heritage.

At this point Avram and Sarai didn't have any children so Sarai told Avram to marry her maid, Hagar. Hagar became pregnant and became rude and disrespectful towards Sarai, and then fled when Sarai treated her harshly in return. An angel told her to go back, and that her son will father a great nation. Yishmael (Ishmael) was born when Avram was 86.

Hashem commanded Avram to have a Brit Milah (circumcision) at the age of 99 and He changed Avram's name to Avraham (Abraham) (meaning father of many nations), and Sarai's to Sarah (meaning princess). He promised that they will have a son who will be the continuation of the great nation of the Jewish people.

Did you know that Lot's shepherds didn't muzzle the animals and Avram's did, until they had permission to graze from the land's owner?

1) Quiz Time

Divide group into two teams and ask them guiz questions based on the Parasha summary. To qualify for answering a question, they need to moo or guack. Team with most points wins.

2) Name Game

Link: Avram and Sarai got new names.

Children sit in a circle and person 1 has the letter A. They have to say; 1) a name beginning with that letter, 2) a place in the world (country, town or city) and 3) an item that you can buy. E.g. Anna, Amsterdam, Apples. Person 2 does the same with B. Bertie, Buenos Aires, Bicycles. Etc.

3) Get off My Land

Link: Avram's shepherds wouldn't allow their sheep to eat freely from the land until they had permission from the owner.

In a large, clear, safe space, the children spread out from each other and sit on a small chair or the floor. Person A (their chair is removed) chases person B (their chair is also removed) around the room. When person B is out of breath, they can run up to someone else and say, "Get off my land!". Person C stands up and starts running and person B takes their seat. If person A catches person C, they switch directions and C is the chaser.

(One of the children can read this out loud – encourage them to use expression.)
